

**Dear Church Pt 11**  
**Hot or Cold>Lukewarm**

**14 "To the angel of the church in Laodicea write: These are the words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the ruler of God's creation. Revelation 3:14**

**20 For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. 2 Corinthians 1:20**

**"I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. John 14:6**

**Jesus is the one and only reliable witness of God because He is God and His story does not change.**

**15 I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other! 16 So, because you are lukewarm—neither hot nor cold—I am about to spit you out of my mouth. Revelation 3:15**

**Indifference is disgusting to the Lord.**

**Because they did not need Jesus for their physical needs, Laodicea did not seek him for their spiritual needs either.**

**17 You say, 'I am rich; I have acquired wealth and do not need a thing.' But you do not realize that you are wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked. Revelation 3:17**

**The absence of conflict and the presence of abundance in our lives can often be Satan's best tools for keeping us ineffective.**

**18 I counsel you to buy from me gold refined in the fire, so you can become rich; and white clothes to wear, so you can cover your shameful nakedness; and salve to put on your eyes, so you can see. Revelation 3:18**

**19 "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. 20 But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. Matthew 6:19-20**

**The more the church mirrors the values of the culture, the less it looks like Jesus.**

**19 Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest and repent. Revelation 3:19**

**20 Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me. Revelation 3:20**

The more areas we close off to Jesus, the more open to compromise we leave ourselves and the more prone to lukewarm we become.

**21 To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with my Father on his throne. 22 Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches.” Revelation 3:14-22**
