3 "To the angel of the church in Sardis write:

These are the words of him who holds the seven spirits of God and the seven stars. I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead.

5 Consider how far you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place. Revelation 2:5

- 4 Characteristics of Dead Churches and Dead Christians
- 1. Just going through the motions.

Each church and each generation needs their own movement of the Spirit to carry them into the uncertainty of the ministry future.

23 Then he (Jesus) said to them all: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. Luke 9:23

2. The practice of vague spirituality that is disconnected from Biblical truth.

Vague spirituality is incredibly attractive in a world that is increasingly hostile toward moral absolutes.

3. An incomplete picture of the Gospel.

20 The seed falling on rocky ground refers to someone who hears the word and at once receives it with joy. 21 But since they have no root, they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall away. Matthew 13:20-21

An incomplete picture of the Gospel causes death in the church because it gives people the illusion of salvation.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! 2 Corinthians 5:17

4. Giving the right energy to the wrong things.

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Acts 2:42

When we serve people for God's sake, we are given an inexhaustible portion of God's grace, but when we serve for people's sake, it's just exhausting.

2 Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have found your deeds unfinished in the sight of my God. 3 Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; hold it fast, and repent.

We must confess our sins of complacency and self-sufficiency and give control to Jesus where it belongs.
