12 "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.

The greater works that Jesus was referring to are not always greater in power but greater in <u>extent</u>.

Does your life and direction reflect that Jesus is helpful or that He is essential?

"... You are not your own, 20 for you were bought with a price. So glorify God..."

We typically don't pray for one of two reasons:

- 1. We don't think it will make a difference in our lives.
- 2. We don't want it to make a difference in our lives.

19 And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:19

God will grant our requests if they reflect a <u>heart</u> for bringing glory and honor to Jesus.

To ask in Jesus name is to <u>humbly</u> recognize that I have no name in Heaven.
