**12 “Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.
John 14:12**

The greater works that Jesus was referring to are not always greater in power but greater in extent.

2. We don't want it to make a difference in our lives.
