



Rooted in Doctrine

Starting next week on June 7th, we are going to begin a series within our *Rooted* theme about doctrine. *Rooted in Doctrine* will be focused on helping us better understand some of our foundational beliefs. A Doctrine is what the whole Bible, not just isolated parts and individual scriptures teaches us about specific topics. These topics include but are not limited to: The Doctrine of The Word of God, The Doctrine of God, Doctrines of Man, Christ, Redemption, The Church and The Future. Even within these topics we will be able to explore other topics of interest like The Trinity, creation, prayer, grace, baptism, communion, and the gifts of the Holy Spirit, just to name a few potential candidates.

This special focus also comes with a warning. Much of what we will be learning is *not* being put forth for discussion or spoken of as theoretical. What may be difficult for some people to understand is that as a church, The Well does not have a “developing or evolving theology.” We *are not* trying to figure things out as we go along. We consistently navigate through life and culture following certain fixed positions of doctrine and theology that inform all of the decisions that we make. Upfront I can assure you that there are going to be some things that stretch us or maybe we don’t like to hear because it is not unusual for the Bible to come into direct opposition to ways that we prefer to believe and live.

In the end it is my goal to see the Holy Spirit continue the change process in all of us so that we can be the kind of grace-filled, Spirit-led disciples that can reach a lost and hurting world for Christ.

Praise the Lord!


Neighborhood Kids - GLOW
